LOGO & SLOGAN CONTEST

The Town of Rockland, Brown County is looking for an original logo and slogan that best represents the identity of the Town. The winning slogan and winning logo will be featured on the Town's letterhead, website, e-mail and promotional materials. A slogan is a short catch phrase that best promotes the Town of Rockland in a positive way. A logo is artwork or an image that best represents who Rockland is in a positive way.

RULES:

- Contests are open to anyone over the age of 13.
- One entry per person, per contest, please.
- Entry deadline for each contest is January 4, 2016.
- Entry must include first and last name, address, phone number, e-mail address and date of birth.
- Entries may be submitted electronically via e-mail to Clerk Jann Charette at jcharette@townofrockland.org or in person /by mail to: Town of Rockland, 1712 Bob-Bea-Jan Road, De Pere, WI 54115.
- The winning entry of each contest becomes the property of the Town of Rockland upon acceptance of award by contestant.
- No entry may use an image or slogan that is legally protected or copyrighted. Any entry doing so will be disqualified from the contest.

CRITERIA:

- Each entry will be judged on how well it accurately displays the Town of Rockland's work ethic, agricultural heritage, topography, and quality of life in a positive way.

PRIZES:

- A \$125.00 will be awarded to the winner of the selected slogan.
- A \$125.00 will be awarded to the winner of the selected logo.

DETERMINATION:

- The Rockland Planning Commission will meet in January 2016 to review the submitted entries. The top 5 entries in each contest will be chosen and forwarded to the Rockland Town Board for final determination of the winners. Winners will be notified and presented their respective prize at a Town Board meeting in late January or early February 2016.
