Town Board Meeting Minutes
Monday, June 4 2018, at the Rockland Town Hall
Called to order by Chairman Cashman at 7:30 p.m.
Adjourned at 8:10 p.m.

The Treasurer, and all members of the Board were present along with Terry Vertz and Steve Gander, and Tom Collins (Wrightstown Spirit). The Clerk and Bob Gerbers were excused for graduation. Dennis verified that the meeting was properly noticed; the agenda was presented after the pledge of allegiance was recited.

Minutes from May 21, 2018, Town Board meeting

No corrections were noted, M/M by Chairman Cashman to approve the May 21, 2018 Town Board meeting minutes as presented with the noted corrections listed above; seconded by Supervisor Meeuwsen. Motion carried.

Reports/Updates as presented:

Building Inspector

Chairman Cashman reviewed the report created by Bob Gerbers. Bob issued a permit for a new home at 5624 Morrison Road, a remodel and sign permit, blasting permits for NEA and utility permits. The total value of the work \$362,000. No questions were asked.

Chairman's Report

1. Chairman Cashman – Paul Gevers from Michel's Foundations got back to him regarding the estimate to fix the Old Martin Culvert. He read the email which stipulates vegetation removal be done by the Town. The estimate for the Michel's portion is \$150,000. They would demo the slab of concrete between two existing pipes. That would allow for sheet pile to be installed. The intent is to cover the existing face of the stone cobble walls. Two weight walls would be installed on each side to protect from erosion and runoff. Two 48" pipes, both 20' long, would be installed inside each of the 60" pipes. Lastly the void would be filled with new concrete to complete a new wall. Comments are that the estimate is very high. The prevailing thought is to find additional solutions and then evaluate them all together. Chairman Cashman will contact Wayne Carter and another company for additional ideas. It will require a big backhoe because of the depth.
2. Urban Tree Service removed and trimmed trees on Old Martin near Sportsman's.
3. Chairman Cashman talked to Wayne Carter about filling potholes. Carter's crew was out Friday, and went back out Monday.
4. Two companies were called about the guardrails along Old Martin. One is near Brillion; they will meet Dennis in coming weeks. The other company called back after a week and will talk this week.
5. Someone dropped 13 tires along Midway Road overnight. Dennis will pick them up this week. There was also a couch picked up.
6. On Friday, Chairman Cashman responded to another incident concerning the Helsel's dog. She was seen at 3546 STH 57, and also at 3829 Seven Oaks where it caught a rooster. Chairman Cashman called the BC Sherriff's Department. Eventually, Alan surrendered the dog to Dennis. It will likely end up at Humane Society unless a rescue can be located.

M/M by Chairman Cashman to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m.; seconded by Supervisor Meeuwsen. Motion carried.


